Read Across America With Dr. Seuss Feb. 26 - March 2

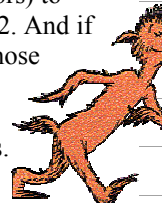
“Read Across America” activities begin Monday,

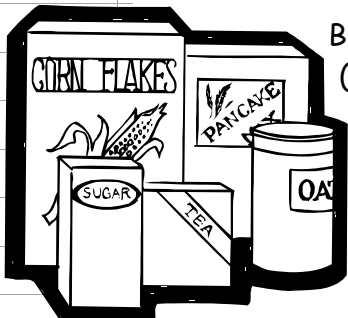
