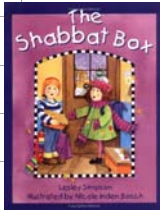

The Shabbat Box by Lesley Simpson

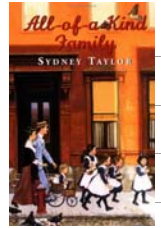
